# REGULAR MEETING SOUTH BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS – DISTRICT #2 April 18, 2016

#### 1. CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Spahr at 7:00 pm followed by a salute to the flag.

#### 2. NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

Chairman Spahr read the Public Laws Meeting Notice of the Public Laws of 1975.

#### 3. ROLL CALL

Comm. Potts made a motion to amend the meeting agenda to move Item A under New Business, seconded by Comm. Smith and by a voice vote all voted in affirmative.

#### 8. NEW BUSINESS

### A. Presentation by Fire & Safety Services on HGAC and Lease Purchasing

David Russell and Kevin Driscoll from Fire & Safety Services gave a presentation on the Houston-Galveston Area Council cooperative purchasing program and lease-financing for the purchase of fire apparatus. After a brief question and answer session, the meeting resumed following the posted meeting agenda.

#### 4. PUBLIC COMMENT

No one from the floor desired to address the Board.

#### 5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

### A. March 21, 2016 Regular Meeting

Comm. Smith made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 21, 2016 regular meeting, seconded by Comm. Wolfe.

#### 6. PROFESSIONAL REPORTS

#### A. Chief's Report

Chief Scott Smith reviewed the Fire Department's March 2016 activity report (see attached).

Chief Smith reported that the line officers were adjusting the spacing of the turnout gear racks at the stations to give firefighters more room to store their turnout gear. Chief Smith further reported that an additional gear rack will be ordered for Station 20.

#### B. District Coordinator's Report

Coordinator Scott Smith reviewed the April 2016 Coordinator's Report (see attached).

#### C. Insurance Chairman's Report

Coordinator Smith reviewed the April 2016 Insurance Report (see attached).

### D. Treasurer's Report

Comm. Young reported that he signed and returned the 2016 audit engagement letter on April 1<sup>st</sup>.

Comm. Young reported that there were three deposits since the last meeting. The first deposit was made on March 23<sup>rd</sup> in the amount of \$844.87 from Glatfelder Insurance Group for the removal of the 1997 Ford F-250 pick-up from insurance coverage following the sale of the vehicle. The second deposit was made on March 29<sup>th</sup> in the amount of \$235,118.75 from South Brunswick Township for first quarter taxation. The third deposit was made on March 30<sup>th</sup> in the amount of \$90.00 from Gov Deals for the sale of the treadmill that was declared surplus.

Comm. Young reported that he received three checks from Lincoln Financial Group totaling \$8,482.22 for the forfeiture of LOSAP funds for three individuals, which will be deposited this week.

Comm. Young reported that he distributed several reports to the Commissioner's mailboxes earlier today. These reports include the final financials from 2015, the fixed asset account group schedule through the end of 2015, and the 2016 year-to-date financials through this meeting.

Comm. Young reported that he closed out the books for 2015 and forwarded the financial data to the auditor electronically. Comm. Young further reported that he gathered all of the monthly financial records for the last year and that they are ready to be delivered to the auditor upon his request.

Comm. Young summarized the final financial report for 2015 (see attached). Comm. Young reported that the general fund balance ended the year at \$389,511.38, which is lower than the \$412,111.89 that the District started the year. The capital fund balance ended the year at \$284,866.97, which is slightly higher than the \$284,794.71 the District started the year. Comm. Young further reported that the District ended the year with a net book value of \$3,100,174.61.

#### E. Legislative Report

Comm. Potts reported that he received an email this afternoon informing him that Assemblyman Burizchelli has introduced a bill to force all governmental entities to move their election to November who have not already done so.

#### 8. NEW BUSINESS

# A. Presentation by Fire & Safety Services on HGAC and Lease Purchasing Discussed earlier in the meeting following Roll Call.

#### B. Discussion/Approval on Fire Station Parking Lot Sealing

Coordinator Smith reported that he contacted Alizio Seal Coating to obtain a quote to seal the cracks in the parking lots at both stations. Coordinator Smith further reported that the cost should not exceed \$2,500.00. Comm. Wolfe expressed his opinion that the Board should obtain quotes to mill and pave the parking lot at Station 20 due to deterioration in several spots. After a brief discussion, Coordinator Smith will begin obtaining quotes prior to 2017 budget planning.

Comm. Wolfe made a motion to approve the parking lot seal cracking by Alizio Seal Coating at a cost not to exceed \$2,500.00, seconded by Comm. Young.

## C. Items Timely and Important

Comm. Young reminded the Commissioners to submit their Financial Disclosure statements prior to April 30<sup>th</sup>.

Comm. Potts reported that three checks were received from Lincoln Financial Group for LOSAP accounts that were closed. Comm. Potts reported that two of the accounts were for members that left the Fire Department prior to vesting. Comm. Potts further reported that the third account was for a member that has not left the Fire Department but has not qualified for the last two years and is not vested. Comm. Potts reported that he left \$300.00 in the account for the individual that is still a member as the account cannot be left open with no funds. Following a brief discussion, a closed session will be scheduled for the start of the May District meeting to discuss the accounts for specific individuals and possible changes to the LOSAP program.

Chairman Spahr reported that Comm. Wolfe will serve as the supervisor for Coordinator Smith.

Comm. Young reported that the Fire Department submitted a list of items to the District they would like to have purchased for the weight room at Station 20.

Comm. Young made a motion to approve the purchase of miscellaneous items for the weight room at a cost not to exceed \$280.82, seconded by Comm. Potts.

- Installers from Computer Systems & Methods were on site on 3-22-2016 to install the new docking station and computer in Car 210.
- TruGreen performed the lawn treatment at both fire stations on 3-22-2016.
- Clearview Window Washing was at Station 20 on 3-23-2016 to clean the windows inside and out and the window blinds.
- Quick Response Fire Protection performed the quarterly sprinkler service at both stations on 4-5-2016. All systems are in proper working order at this time.
- Access Health Systems was at Station 20 on 4-7-2016 to perform the annual firefighter physicals. A total of 22 firefighters completed their physical that evening. The remaining firefighters will be completing their physicals at the doctor's office in North Brunswick.
- Engine 208 was taken to Fire & Safety Services on 4-11-2016 for installation of the reverse camera. The mechanics also made repairs to two of the air pack jump seats while they had the vehicle. The truck was back in service on 4-15-2016.
- Antczak's Complete Service performed the carpet cleaning at Stations 20 & 21 on 4-15-2016.
