SPECIAL MEETING SOUTH BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS – DISTRICT #2 December 5, 2016

1. CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Spahr at 7:34 pm followed by a salute to the flag.

2. NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

Chairman Spahr read the Public Laws Meeting Notice of the Public Laws of 1975.

3. ROLL CALL

4. PUBLIC COMMENT

No one from the floor desired to address the Board.

5. ORDER OF BUSINESS

A. Discussion on VFIS Group Term Life Insurance Policy Renewal

Coordinator Smith reported that he received the 2017 renewal packet for the Group Term Life Insurance policy from VFIS with a total cost of \$7,433.72, which is billed quarterly at a rate of \$1,858.43 per quarter. Coordinator Smith further reported that this is a decrease of \$2,037.64 from the 2016 cost of \$9,471.36, which is due to the number of individuals that were removed from the policy at the beginning of the year. Coordinator Smith recommended renewing the Group Term Life Insurance policy with VFIS.

Comm. Smith made a motion to approve the renewal of the Group Term Life Insurance policy with VFIS at a cost of \$7,433.72, seconded by Comm. Wolfe.

Roll call: Comm. Potts - yes, Comm. Smith - yes, Comm. Wolfe - yes, Comm. Young - yes, Chairman Spahr - yes.

B. Final Presentation/Discussion on 2017 Budget

Comm. Young distributed copies of the proposed 2017 budget State package to the Commissioners and reviewed the highlights of the proposal. Comm. Young reported that he received an update from the Tax Assessors office, stating that the base went up by \$23 million. Comm. Young further reported that the amount to be raised by taxation will be the same as 2016 and that the tax rate will also remain the same at 0.46. Comm. Young reported that with the approval of Resolution #16-29, the package can be mailed to the State.

C. Resolution #16-29, Approval of 2017 Budget

Comm. Wolfe made a motion to approve Resolution #16-29, seconded by Comm. Smith.

Roll call: Comm. Potts - yes, Comm. Smith - yes, Comm. Wolfe - yes, Comm. Young - yes, Chairman Spahr - yes.

D. Resolution #16-30, Authorizing the Transfer of Funds Relative to the 2016 Budget Comm. Young reported that the date of the pre-build meeting at Pierce Manufacturing, Inc. to review the specifications of the new fire truck was originally anticipated to occur in early 2017 but has been moved to this month. Comm. Young further reported that budget line item A-8 Travel Expenses was originally funded at \$3,000.00. Comm. Young reported that the transfer will move \$4,000.00 from line item A-1 Administrative Salaries & Wages to line item A-8 for a total amount of \$7,000.00.

Comm. Potts made a motion to approve Resolution #16-30, seconded by Comm. Smith. Roll call: Comm. Potts - yes, Comm. Smith - yes, Comm. Wolfe - yes, Comm. Young - yes, Chairman Spahr - yes.

E. Items Timely and Important

Comm. Smith reported that he has worked on obtaining quotes for the painting of both bathrooms at Station 21 and the workout room at Station 20. Comm. Smith reported that he received a quote of \$1,000.00 from Vincze Home Improvement LLC. Comm. Smith further reported that he contacted a second vendor to obtain another estimate but did not receive a call back.

Comm. Young made a motion to approve the painting at a total cost of \$1,000.00, seconded by Comm. Wolfe.

Roll call: Comm. Potts - yes, Comm. Smith - yes, Comm. Wolfe - yes, Comm. Young - yes, Chairman Spahr - yes.

Comm. Young reported that at the regular December meeting he will have the wording for the capital questions to be included on the ballot for the February election for inclusion in the 2018 budget.

Comm. Potts reported that the State Association of Fire Districts meeting was held here this past Saturday. Comm. Potts further reported that three fire districts had their 2017 budgets rejected by DCA as they did not conduct the public meetings for the appropriate time periods.

Comm. Potts reported that he spoke with the DCA regarding several issues concerning LOSAP. Comm. Potts reported that if a vested member leaves a fire department, withdraws all funds and closes their account, they are no longer considered vested and must start over when joining the same or another department. If any amount of money is left in the account, the member would still be considered vested. Comm. Potts also reported that in a district without LOSAP, if a member is exempt they automatically become vested once a LOSAP program is started.

2017 FIRE DISTRICT BUDGET RESOLUTION NO. 16-29 So. Brunswick Twp. – Fire District No. 2

FISCAL YEAR: January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget for the South Brunswick Fire District No. 2 (the "Fire District") for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2017 and ending December 31, 2017 has been presented before the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District at its open public meeting of December 5, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the budget as introduced is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44 et. seq.);and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$1,240,653, which includes an amount to be raised by taxation of \$940,475, and Total Appropriations of \$1,240,653; and

WHEREAS, the amount to be raised by taxation to support the district budget shall be the amount to be certified to the assessor of the municipality to be assessed against the taxable property in the district, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-79. Such amount shall be equal to the amount of the total appropriations set forth in the budget minus the total amount surplus and miscellaneous revenues set forth in the budget; and

WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District, at an open public meeting held on December 5, 2016 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2017 and ending December 31, 2017 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the Fire District's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District will consider the Annual Budget for adoption on January 17, 2017.
