## SPECIAL BUDGET MEETING SOUTH BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS – DISTRICT #2 December 6, 2021

## 1. CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Spahr at 7:00 pm followed by a salute to the flag.

#### 2. NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

Chairman Spahr read the Public Laws Meeting Notice of the Public Laws of 1975.

## 5. ORDER OF BUSINESS

## A. Final Presentation/Discussion on 2022 Budget

Comm. Young distributed copies of the proposed 2022 budget and supporting documentation package to the Commissioners. Comm. Young reported that there were no changes to any of the financials for the 2022 budget as presented last month. Comm. Young reported that the 2022 projected ratable base received from the Tax Assessors office shows an increase of approximately \$17 million compared to the 2021 actual ratable base. Comm. Young further reported that the total appropriations for 2022 is \$1,232,873, an increase of approximately \$32,205 from the 2021 budget. The amount to be raised by taxation is \$1,056,000, an increase of approximately \$20,000.00 from 2021. The tax rate for 2021 is budgeted at .043 per hundred, which is .001 lower than the 2021 budgeted rate and the same as the realized rate. Comm. Young reported that with the approval of Resolution #21-22, the documents can be sent electronically to the Department of Community Affairs and posted on the fire district website. Comm. Young reported that there will be a public hearing and formal adoption of the budget at the January 2022 regular meeting.

## B. Resolution #21-22, Approval of 2022 Budget

Comm. Smith made a motion to approve Resolution #21-22, seconded by Comm. Wolfe. Roll call: Comm. Kazanski - yes, Comm. Smith - yes, Comm. Wolfe - yes, Comm. Young - yes, Chairman Spahr - yes. Motion Passed.

## 2022 FIRE DISTRICT BUDGET RESOLUTION

# South Brunswick Township FD No. 2

## FISCAL YEAR: January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget for South Brunswick Township FD No. 2 (the 'Fire District') for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2022 and ending December 31, 2022 has been presented before the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District at its open public meeting of December 6, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the budget as introduced is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$1,232,873.00 which includes an amount to be raised by taxation of \$1,056,000.00 and Total Appropriations of \$1,232,873.00; and

WHEREAS, the amount to be raised by taxation to support the district budget shall be the amount to be certified to the assessor of the municipality to be assessed against the taxable property in the district, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-79. Such amount shall be equal to the amount of the total appropriations set forth in the budget minus the total amount surplus and miscellaneous revenues set forth in the budget; and

WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District, at an open public meeting held on December 6, 2021 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2022 and ending December 31, 2022 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the Fire District's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District will consider the Annual Budget for adoption on January 18, 2022.
