REGULAR MEETING SOUTH BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS – DISTRICT #2 August 19, 2024

1. CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith at 7:00 pm followed by a salute to the flag.

2. NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

Chairman Smith read the Public Laws Meeting Notice of the Public Laws of 1975.

3. ROLL CALL

4. PUBLIC COMMENT

No one from the floor desired to address the Board.

5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A. July 15, 2024 Regular Meeting

Comm. Wolfe made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 15, 2024 regular meeting, seconded by Comm. Spahr.

Roll call: Comm. Kazanski - yes, Comm. Spahr - yes, Comm. Wolfe - yes, Comm. Young - yes, Chairman Smith - yes. Motion Passed.

6. PROFESSIONAL REPORTS

A. Fire Chief's Report

Chief Scott Smith reviewed the Fire Department's July 2024 activity report (see attached).

Chief Smith reported that the Fire Department held a joint 100th anniversary celebration with the Kingston Fire Company which included a motorcade and picnic on July 27th. Chief Smith thanked the Commissioners for presenting a resolution recognizing the anniversary and for providing the t-shirts for the membership.

Chief Smith reported that junior firefighter Nick Miele turned 18 years of age and is now a probationary firefighter. Chief Smith also reported that the Fire Department has a new probationary firefighter, Anshul Chettri.

B. District Coordinator's Report

Coordinator Scott Smith reviewed the August 2024 Coordinator's Report (see attached).

C. Insurance Chairman's Report

Coordinator Smith reviewed the August 2024 Insurance Report (see attached).

D. Treasurer's Report

Comm. Young reported that there were no deposits since the last meeting.

Comm. Young reported that he distributed the latest financial reports to the Commissioner's prior to the meeting.

Comm. Young reported that he has begun compiling data for the 2025 budget, to include an updated 5-year projection out to 2029.

E. Legislative Report

Comm. Young reported that the next meeting of the State Association of Fire Districts will be held during the Wildwood convention on Friday September 13th at 1 PM.

7. OLD BUSINESS

There was no Old Business to discuss.

8. NEW BUSINESS

A. Resolution #24-24, Requesting Approval of Items of Revenue and Appropriation (N.J.S.A. 40A:14-78.5)

Comm. Young reported that with the receipt of a \$45,000 grant through the State's American Rescue Plan Firefighter Grant, the district will need to perform a budget amendment. The total project amounts to \$50,000, which includes \$5,000 in matching funds that will be taken from Line Item O-8 Uniforms. Comm. Young reported that Local Finance Notice 2012-11 details specifics of the amendment process, which includes a resolution and certification form that must be completed and sent to the DCA for review.

Comm. Spahr made a motion to approve Resolution #24-24, seconded by Comm. Wolfe Roll call: Comm. Kazanski - yes, Comm. Spahr - yes, Comm. Wolfe - yes, Comm. Young - yes, Chairman Smith - yes. Motion Passed.

B. Discussion on Purchase of Equipment for American Rescue Plan Firefighter Grant Coordinator Smith reported that with the grant award, the following equipment has been ordered: (11) structural firefighting helmets with leather fronts, (8) sets of turnout gear, and (15) nomex hoods. Coordinator Smith further reported that there is approximately \$4,600 in grant funds remaining, and that the district has until June 2026 to utilize those funds.

C. Resolution #24-30, Authorizing Creation of Paid Position of Firefighter

Comm. Young made a motion to approve Resolution #24-30, seconded by Comm. Wolfe <u>Roll call:</u> Comm. Kazanski - yes, Comm. Spahr - yes, Comm. Wolfe - yes, Comm. Young - yes, Chairman Smith - yes. Motion Passed.

D. Discussion on Sale of Bronto Sky-Lift

Coordinator Smith reported that the 2003 E-One Bronto Sky-Lift has been listed for sale on the Firetee and Brindlee Mountain Fire Apparatus websites for approximately 3 months at a

price of \$200,000. To date, there has been only one inquiry made on the price with no offers. Coordinator Smith further reported that both companies feel the asking price is fair, but the potential buyer market is limited due to the specialized nature of the truck. As such, it was recommended to consider lowering the price and to determine the Board's "bottom dollar" sale price.

Coordinator Smith reported that construction of the new aerial is scheduled to start in late September, with the final inspection trip targeted for early December. Coordinator Smith anticipates the new truck being placed in service sometime in the spring once training is completed.

After a discussion, it was the consensus of the Board to lower the asking price for the Bronto to \$150,000, then reassess as needed at the end of the year.

E. Items Timely and Important

Chairman Smith reported he has obtained copies of the contracts for the full-time staff from Fire Districts 1 & 3. Chairman Smith further reported that the contracts of the full-time staff from all three districts expire at the end of the year, and that it is his goal to work with the other districts to standardize the salary and benefits of the employees where possible in the new contracts.

9. VOUCHER LIST

Comm. Young reported that the voucher list has been amended to included one additional item; Item Y to McMaster-Carr in the amount of \$576.42.

Comm. Wolfe made a motion to approve the voucher list as amended, seconded by Comm. Spahr.

Fire District Coordinator's Report August 19, 2024

- The current Car 210 (2014 Chevrolet Tahoe) went to East Coast Emergency Lighting on 7-22-2024 to have equipment removed in preparation for installation in the new chief's vehicle. The car was back the next day, when the current Car 200 (2019 Chevrolet Tahoe) went to have the computer swapped. The new chief's car went to East Coast today for the final up-fitting including warning package, front console, rear command cabinet, and equipment chargers.
- A mechanic from Fire & Safety Services was at Station 20 on 7-24-2024 to replace the batteries in Engine 204.
- Bunker Hill Tree Service was at Station 20 on 7-29-2024 to remove a tree that split and came down in the rear of the site.
- A mechanic from Fire & Safety Services was at Station 21 on 8-2-2024 to replace the sight glass in the radiator on Engine 206, which was cracked and causing a coolant leak. The mechanic also troubleshot an issue with the AC, which was determined to be a compressor clutch in need of replacement.
- Antczak's Complete Service was at Station 20 on 8-2-2024 to clean the upholstery on the high-back chairs in the member's room. I have scheduled a return visit for next week to have the tile floors in the bathrooms steam-cleaned.
- A tech from TLP Climate Control Systems was at Station 20 on 8-12-2024 to troubleshoot an issue with the air conditioning systems for the member's room and gym. A capacitor was replaced in the member's room system and it is working properly at this time. The gym system was inspected and reset, and is working properly at this time as well.
- A mechanic from Fire & Safety Services was at Station 20 today to troubleshoot the activation of several dashboard warning lights. It was determined a module has gone bad and a replacement has been ordered.

Insurance:

 We received notification on 8-14-2024 that Nottingham Insurance in Hamilton Square will be serving as the regional director and marketing coordinator for VFIS.
 This change will give us a local point of contact for day-to-day needs such as policy changes, certificate requests and any questions relating to our coverages.

Requesting Approval of Items of Revenue and Appropriation (N.J.S.A. 40A:14-78.5)

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:14-78.5 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any Fire District when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, the Director may also approve the insertion of an item of appropriation for an equal amount; and

WHERAS, the Commissioners of Fire District No. 2 in the Township of South Brunswick, County of Middlesex made application to the State of New Jersey's American Rescue Plan Firefighter Grant for the purchase of personal protective equipment; and

WHERAS, the State of New Jersey has advised the Board of Fire Commissioners that the application has been approved, and the Board of Fire Commissioners are desirous of accepting said appropriation in making the purchases outlined in the application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commissioners of Fire District No. 2 in the Township of South Brunswick, County of Middlesex hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget of the year 2024 in the sum of \$45,000, which is now available from the State of New Jersey's American Rescue Plan Firefighter Grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the like sum of \$45,000 is hereby appropriated under the caption "ARP-FFG Grant"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the sum of \$5,000 representing the amount required for the Fire District's share of the aforementioned undertaking or improvement appears in the budget of the year 2024 under the caption "Turnout Gear/Uniforms" and is hereby re-appropriated under the caption of "Turnout Gear – ARP-FFG 10% Match".

Authorizing Creation of Paid Position of Firefighter

WHEREAS, there exists a need within Fire District No. 2 in the Township of South Brunswick, County of Middlesex, to create a paid position entitled "Firefighter" to perform those duties as necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Fire District No. 2 in the Township of South Brunswick, County of Middlesex have determined that they are desirous of creating said position.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Fire District No. 2 in the Township of South Brunswick, County of Middlesex, as follows:

- (1) The position of "Firefighter" is hereby established.
- (2) The annual salary, benefits, and terms and conditions of employment for this position shall be as determined by the Commissioners and as otherwise mandated by New Jersey statutory law.
- (3) The position of "Firefighter" shall undertake any and all duties, responsibilities and functions as determined necessary by the Commissioners.
- (4) The position of "Firefighter" shall be under the supervision of the Commissioners as designated by the Commissioners pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 14-81.3.
- (5) This resolution shall take effect following final adoption and publication pursuant to New Jersey statutory law.

NOTICE is hereby given that the above resolution will be introduced for a first reading at a regular meeting of the Commissioners to be held on August 19, 2024, and will be considered for final passage at a regular meeting to be held on September 16, 2024, at 7:00 P.M., at the Monmouth Junction Fire House, 573 Ridge Road, Monmouth Junction, New Jersey, at which time and place any person wishing to be heard shall be given the opportunity.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that copies of said resolution shall be made available to each person requesting a copy of same during the week prior to the second reading of this resolution and during the hearing concerning the same, and said copies may be obtained from the Commissioners.
