# REGULAR MEETING SOUTH BRUNSWICK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS – DISTRICT #2 September 16, 2024



#### 1. CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith at 7:00 pm followed by a salute to the flag.

#### 2. NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

Chairman Smith read the Public Laws Meeting Notice of the Public Laws of 1975.

#### 4. PUBLIC COMMENT

#### 5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

#### A. August 19, 2024 Regular Meeting

Comm. Spahr made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 19, 2024 regular meeting, seconded by Comm. Wolfe.

#### 6. PROFESSIONAL REPORTS

#### A. Fire Chief's Report

Chief Scott Smith reviewed the Fire Department's August 2024 activity report (see attached).

Chief Smith reported that the Middlesex County DOT installed signage and put down striping on the roadway in front of Station 21 last month to provide warning for motorists to increase safety as fire apparatus exits and returns to the building.

Chief Smith reported that two members started Firefighter I at the Middlesex County Fire Academy and three others started Firefighter II at the Somerset County Fire Academy earlier this month. Chief Smith further reported that several members are taking part in joint motor vehicle extrication training with the other township departments.

Chief Smith reported that the Fire Department has one new junior firefighter, Diya Shah.

Chief Smith reported that Tactical Public Safety is troubleshooting intermittent issues with the paging system. It is believed that a cell tower on Route 1 is causing the interference.

### B. District Coordinator's Report

Coordinator Scott Smith reviewed the September 2024 Coordinator's Report (see attached).

#### C. Insurance Chairman's Report

Coordinator Smith reviewed the September 2024 Insurance Report (see attached).

#### D. Treasurer's Report

Comm. Young reported that there was one deposit since the last meeting. The deposit was made on August 30<sup>th</sup> in the amount of \$9,853.25 from South Brunswick Township out of the dedicated penalty account for reimbursement of the purchase of a portable radio from Fire District #3.

Comm. Young reported that he distributed the latest financial reports to the Commissioner's mailboxes this afternoon.

Comm. Young reported that he continues to work on the draft 2025 budget and an updated 5-year projection. Comm. Young further reported that the State released the budget forms and that he has begun imputing figures. There will be a first review of the 2025 budget next month.

Comm. Young reported that he attempted to connect virtually to the State Association of Fire Districts meeting last week but was unable to do so.

#### C. Discussion on Renewal of Station 20 HVAC Maintenance Contract

Coordinator Smith reported that he received the maintenance contract renewal for the Station 20 HVAC systems from TLP Climate Control Systems at a cost of \$1,326.00. The contract is for the remainder of 2024, which includes two service visits at a cost of \$663.00 per visit. Coordinator Smith recommended renewing the maintenance contract with TLP Climate Control Systems.

Comm. Young made a motion to approve the renewal of the Station 20 HVAC maintenance contract with TLP Climate Control Systems at a price of \$1,326.00, seconded by Comm. Spahr.

Chairman Smith expressed his goal to standardize the contracts and salaries as much as possible. Chairman Smith has reviewed the proposal in detail and will speak with the members of the Board to develop a consensus proposal, and present that proposal to the representatives of the fire districts at the next joint meeting.

Coordinator Smith reported that Deputy Fire District Coordinator Pedro Sanchez completed the Fire Inspector program and will need to submit the application and fee to the State to obtain certification. Coordinator Smith asked the Board to consider paying the fee for the certification, which is renewed every 3 years. After discussion, it was the consensus of the Board to reimburse employees for renewal of certifications.

# Fire District Coordinator's Report September 16, 2024

- As reported last month, the new chief's vehicle went to East Coast Emergency Lighting on 8-19-2024 for the up-fitting including warning package, front console, rear command cabinet, and equipment chargers. East Coast should finish their work by the end of this week. The last part of the project is the installation of the mobile radio, which should be completed next week.
- Trugreen performed a lawn treatment at both stations on 8-21-2024.
- Antczak's Complete Service was at Station 20 on 8-26-2024 to steam clean the tile floors in the men's and women's bathrooms.
- We received emails from the State Government Records Council on 8-28-2024 regarding OPRA requests. The State requires all agencies subject to OPRA to adopt their model form going forward. The form has been downloaded and will be submitted to any individual who wishes to submit a request.
- Sodexo Roth was at Station 20 on 9-8-2024 to perform the annual roof preventive maintenance.
- Quick Response Fire Protection performed the annual sprinkler system inspection at both stations on 9-9-2024.
- Waterway, Inc. performed the annual hose testing on 9-11-2024. One length of 5" hose failed; as we had a spare length a replacement is not needed.
- TLP Climate Control Systems was at Station 20 on 9-12-2024 to perform scheduled maintenance on the HVAC systems. The techs also replaced a defective motor, blade and capacitor for the member's room air conditioner.
- Approved Fire Protection was on site on 9-12-2024 to perform the annual inspection of the fire extinguishers on the trucks and at the stations. Several extinguishers were taken for recharging or hydrostatic testing.

#### Insurance:

• There is an invoice on the voucher list to Glatfelter Specialty Benefits in the amount of \$1,887.75 for the fourth and final installment on the group term life insurance policy.

# Authorizing Creation of Paid Position of Firefighter

WHEREAS, there exists a need within Fire District No. 2 in the Township of South Brunswick, County of Middlesex, to create a paid position entitled "Firefighter" to perform those duties as necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Fire District No. 2 in the Township of South Brunswick, County of Middlesex have determined that they are desirous of creating said position.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Fire District No. 2 in the Township of South Brunswick, County of Middlesex, as follows:

(1) The position of "Firefighter" is hereby established.

(2) The annual salary, benefits, and terms and conditions of employment for this position shall be as determined by the Commissioners and as otherwise mandated by New Jersey statutory law.

(3) The position of "Firefighter" shall undertake any and all duties, responsibilities and

functions as determined necessary by the Commissioners.

(4) The position of "Firefighter" shall be under the supervision of the Commissioners as designated by the Commissioners pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 14-81.3.

(5) This resolution shall take effect following final adoption and publication pursuant to New Jersey statutory law.

NOTICE is hereby given that the above resolution was introduced and passed upon first reading at a regular meeting of the Commissioners held on August 19, 2024 and will be considered for final passage at a regular meeting to be held on September 16, 2024, at 7:00 P.M., at the Monmouth Junction Fire House, 573 Ridge Road, Monmouth Junction, New Jersey, at which time and place any person wishing to be heard shall be given the opportunity.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that copies of said resolution shall be made available to each person requesting a copy of same during the week prior to the second reading of this resolution and during the hearing concerning the same, and said copies may be obtained from the Commissioners.
